

Free Travel on Public Transport Protect yourself

With effect from **1st November 2015** the Chief Constable has directed that the terms of any previous informal agreement with ARRIVA Wales (buses and Trains) be revised. As of this date, free travel on Arriva Buses and Trains is only available to both police officers and police community support officers **whilst on duty only**.

Police Officers - applies both in uniform and plain clothes; the officer must be on duty at the time and undertaking the journey in connection with a policing purpose. Officers are expressly prohibited from seeking to obtain; or accepting any form of free travel concession whilst off duty (including any commute to /from home to a place of work or other location).
